

 LABI Department store & new
 Miyashita Park mall.

- Visit designer stores along Omotesando
- Take a photo of crazy mirrors at Tokyu Plaza entrance
- Don't miss Meiji-jingu,
 Tokyo's major Shinto shrine
- Visit offbeat Togo Shrine

- Happy Pancake (soufflé pancakes)

Things to do in Shinjuku

- Find your way out of one of the 200 exits at Shinjuku Station. The station is an attraction in itself
- Explore Shinjuku Gyoen for some tranquility
- Take some nostalgic photos along smoky Omoide Yochoko (Memory Lane)
- Find Godzilla perched on a rooftop on Godzilla Street
- Don't miss Shinjuku no Nekomae, the resident cat on a 3D TV
- Enjoy the bright lights & nightlife of Kabukicho.

Things to do in Asakusa

- Discover marvellous Senso-ji, Tokyo's 7th century Buddhist temple site. The structures were destroyed in the firebombing of Tokyo during WWII & rebuilt (you can still see burnt scars on trees here)
- Enter Senso-ji through the Thunder Gate & enjoy making your way along Nakamise-dori, a lengthy shopping street full of fresh street eats, souvenirs & more
- Don't be shy and find out your fortune with omikuji!
- Visit Asakusa-jinja, tucked away behind Senso-ji.
 It survived the WWII firebombing & features two married stone dogs dating back to the Edo period.
- Within Asakusa-jinja is Hikan-Inari shrine, linked to Kyoto's famous Fushimi Inari
- Enjoy wandering around the many covered arcades
- Laugh at the "Golden Turd" across the Sumida River with the SkyTree & Asahi buildings.



Getting to Akihabara

- Explore nostalgic Super Potato, featuring video games, consoles, toys, gifts etc from the 80's & 90's
- Search for anime, manga, gadgets, electronics, play pachinko - it's all here!
- If you love anime or shrines, don't miss Kanda Myojin. This shrine is over 1,300 years old & you can learn traditional experiences from a geisha here! Read my review & BOOK >

Sumida to Chiyoda

- 25 mins north from Oshiage
 Station on the Asakusa Line
 (switch to Tozai Line)
- Exit at Takebashi Station for Imperial Palace Gardens

Imperial Palace East Gardens, Chiyoda

- Former grounds of Edo Castle (some surviving buildings can be found in <u>Kawagoe</u>, <u>Saitama →</u>)
- Imperial Palace East Gardens close at 16:30

Chiyoda to Ueno

- 25 mins north from Kokyo
 Higashi-gyoen Station on Tozai
 Line (switch to Ginza Line)
- Exit at Ueno Station for Ueno
 Park & Ameya Yokocho

Ameya Yokocho & Ueno Park, Ueno

- Grab a bite to eat beneath the railway tracks at Ameya Yokocho, an amazing open-air market with everything from street eats to cheap souvenirs
- Head to Ueno Park for a relaxing afternoon stroll
- Admire the stunning details of Toshogu Shrine
- Peep through the circular branch of the beloved "Moon Pine" at Kiyomizu Kannon-do
- Witness the beautiful Bentendo Temple overlooking the pond (& hire a swan paddle boat if you wish!)





Things to do in Odaiba

- Start early at popular teamLab Borderless. Do arrive about an hour before opening time & don't forget to book tickets online up to 8 weeks in advance! BOOK →
- Pay a visit to Tokyo Bay,
 Statue of Liberty & Rainbow
 Bridge



Odaiba to Minato

- 25 mins north from Oshiage
 Station on the Asakusa Line
 (switch to Tozai Line)
- Exit at Takebashi Station for Imperial Palace Gardens

Things to do in Minato

- Marvel at Tokyo Tower, stroll around Shiba Park & have a humbling visit to Zojo-ji Temple
- Explore the beauty of Hamarikyu Gardens & enjoy some matcha in the teahouse



Minato to Ginza

- 12 mins north from Daimon
 Station on the Asakusa Line
- Exit at Higashi-ginza Station

 Admire the unique, quirky style of designer store buildings (& shop if you wish!)



- Tokyo Tower Observation Deck →
- Ginza whiskey, cocktail, sake tour →
- Hidden gem food tour Shimbashi →
